**Welcoming and lodging conditions for the competitors and accompanying persons coming from nations outside Europe.**  
(North and South America – Oceania – Asia)



The number of competitors to the event doesn't permit to the organizers, to take in charge the foreigner competitors before the 2 of April 2010 at **Toulouse** and after Monday 5 of April 2010 at **Bordeaux**. We ask you then, to read **attentively** the following advices:

**Transfers :**

All the traveling expenses and transfers in France as well as all the ones from one place of the competition to another competition will be taken in charge by the participants. That needs **imperatively** each delegation to do the necessary to **rent the vehicles** (attention: Easter week-end is a period with overbooking for the location company's of vehicles. So it is necessary to rent as soon as possible to have a car in a category with accessible price).

From Toulouse (or Pibrac) you are expected to do from 600 to 800 km for the three days of the competition plus the transfers depending on your arrival place and departure place out of competition.

## **Commitment and registration:**

### **Attention:**

Registrations received before the 8<sup>th</sup> of March 2010: **0 €**

Registrations received between the 8<sup>th</sup> of March and 21<sup>st</sup> of March 2010: **20 €**

**After the 22<sup>nd</sup> of March registrations will be refused**

**Novelty 2010** to make easier the control of arrivals, the skaters will be inevitably equipped with an individual apparatus of detection (fleas of detection)

**Price of the tenancy: 5€ by skater (deposit 60€).**

### **Lodging:**

The organization of the three track **take in charge** the competitors as well as the accompanying persons in the proportion of 1 manager for 3 competitors ( transfer by car) or one manager for 5 competitors (transfer by bus) for four nights in hotel :

- Two nights in Toulouse, the Friday and the Saturday
- Two nights in Bordeaux, the Sunday and the Monday

The competitors and the accompanying persons will be grouped in 2 or 3persons by bedroom, all the delegations wishing bedrooms for one person will have to ask for it and will have to pay the difference of the price (take in charge of the organization 10 Euros per person, the rest from 20 Euro to 30 Euro the seeker will have to pay for it).

The breakfast and other hotel expenses **will be paid by each delegation.**

Then, the organization should know the **arrival program** of each delegation to tell them **in advance** the place of lodging before their arrival in Toulouse. (If you arrive at Toulouse before Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> of April 2010, it is possible, if we know it a lot of time before, to book you a bedroom in the same hotel, **which you will have to pay.**)

### **Food:**

The organization offers the following meals: Saturday lunch and night at Pibrac, Sunday midday and night at Valence d'Agen and Monday midday at Gujan-Mestras. Tickets of free lunch will be delivered to the delegations.

The participants will have to pay for all the other meals.



All those information's should permit you to take the decision of participating in the competition knowing all about it. Pay attention to all the indications we just gave you. That will avoid any surprise or trouble at your arrival in France. Remember that the event is supported by three clubs with very few people who can not assume, with a lot of regret , all the conditions of welcoming at the level of the importance of that event which is unanimously recognized (out of championship) as the most important trial on track in the world .
